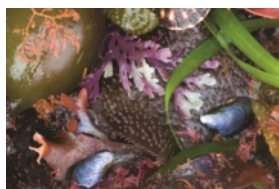
### 01 Sailing With the Soundkeeper

## 07 Sun Valley Condo for Four

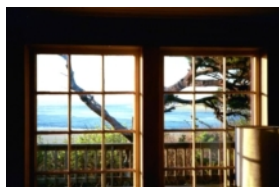
